3. Ementa: Este curso proporciona uma visão ampla do direito e da economia da regulação. Ele é composto por aulas de Análise Econômica do Direito (AED) e aplica o instrumental microeconômico na análise do direito, em especial nas instituições do direito de propriedade, contratos e responsabilidade civil, assim como, às políticas a elas diretamente relacionadas. Procura-se ao mesmo tempo alertar os participantes para as recentes investigações nas várias áreas da AED, bem como encorajar aplicações à realidade brasileira. Ao final do curso, faz-se uma abordagem comportamental do direito e da economia da Regulação.

4. Objetivo: Proporcionar ao aluno a oportunidade de conhecer a uma seleção da literatura de *Law and Economics*, assim como incentivar a utilização desta metodologia na confecção de artigos e da dissertação.
